

(d) if the Divisional event is a non-Conservatory or non-ushered Conservatory event, take a completed critique form, a printed program and/or ticket stub with your Attendance Card to any faculty member of your respective Division for verification and the required signatures as outlined in (c) above.

Note: *a division faculty member must sign attendance cards for every event attended in this category.*

3. Student Discretionary (four)

To receive credit for these events you must:

(a) select and attend any performance, lecture or master class in the performing arts. The choice of events is entirely at your discretion, but you must be able to verify attendance with a printed program, ticket stub or the like.

(b) if the event is an ushered Conservatory event, follow the procedures as outlined above for Conservatory Events, then take your completed critique form, Attendance Card with a printed program and/or ticket stub to a faculty member of your respective Division. The faculty member will verify the information and sign the card (and the program and/or ticket stub) for each event. The teacher will collect the critique forms.

(c) if the event is a non-Conservatory or non-ushered Conservatory event, take a completed critique form, a printed program and/or ticket stub with your Attendance Card to a faculty member or your respective Division for verification and the required signatures as outlined in (c) above.

Note: *Your supervising faculty member must sign attendance cards for every event attended in this category.*

GRADING:

- A = 12 events attended
- B = 10 - 11 events attended
- C = 8 - 9 events attended
- D = 6 - 7 events attended
- F = 5 or fewer events attended

COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS FOR CONSERVATORY EVENTS

- Your UMKC student picture ID card entitles you to one free ticket for each "ticketed" Conservatory event. Tickets must be picked up at the UMKC Box Office (Center for the Performing Arts) not less than 24 hours prior to the performance.

OTHER POLICIES

- **Important:** If your card is lost or destroyed, you must obtain a new card and **begin again!**
- Students must submit completed attendance cards and critique forms to the faculty member in charge of their section of 154 on or before 5pm on the last day of classes. Cards turned in late will result in lower grades at the rate of one letter grade per week. *You are responsible to have all necessary documentation before this time - make appointments early!*

To receive an A in this course your card should have:

- 2 punches each for the 4 events above ON CAMPUS RECITAL/CONCERT
- 4 faculty signatures (plus 2 punches for any on-campus events attended) under DIVISIONAL EVENTS
- 4 faculty signatures (plus 2 punches for any on-campus events attended) under STUDENT DISCRETIONARY EVENTS
- You also must turn in your card to your faculty supervisor in person by 5pm on the last day of classes (if you are concerned, make backup copies - you are responsible if your materials are lost).

- You will not receive credit for any Divisional or Student Discretionary Event without a critique form and faculty signature

Do not have a friend turn your card in for you! This almost invariably results in a late or lost card.
