Chamber Music

August 25 - October 12

Weekly small-group coachings with the Stringendo faculty. Violin, viola, cello and piano students ages 8 – 20 are eligible to participate. We also welcome pre-formed chamber music groups. It is a good opportunity for you to gather your friends for this fun musical adventure. Group placement is by audition (auditions will be held August 23). **\$175.00 (\$100.00 for current CMDA students).**

Stringendo Camerata and Stringendo Sinfonia *October 13 - December 17*

Stringendo Camerata and Stringendo Sinfonia are youth string orchestras for violin, viola, cello, and bass students ages 8 – 20. Weekly rehearsals culminate in a public performance. The Stringendo faculty works with participants on music fundamentals as well as ensemble skills. Placement is by audition; auditions will be held October 4.

Stringendo Summer Camp

Summer session

Violin, viola, cello and piano students ages 7 – 20 are eligible to participate in this fun, intensive 12-day camp. The Stringendo faculty and special guest artists will present workshops and classes on all aspects of musicmaking, from proper posture and breathing to artistic interpretation. Participants will perform in small groups and in a camp orchestra. All levels are welcome. An audition is required.
