LIVE AUDITION REPERTOIRE

Specific repertoire for the audition, including number of pieces and length, may be chosen by applicants. For any questions about audition repertoire, please contact Professor Jarrett McCourt.

Undergraduate level

- Two contrasting solo pieces of your choosing from the options below:
 - o Air and Bourée (Bach trans. Bell)
 - o Andante and Rondo (Capuzzi)
 - Concerto for Bass Tuba (Vaughan Williams)
 - Sonata (Hindemith)

- Concerto in One Movement (Lebedev)
- o Sonatas 1-6 (Marcello)
- o Concerto for Tuba (Gregson)
- o Introduction and Dance (Barat)
- Selected repertoire may be separate pieces, or a movement that includes different styles.
- Repertoire may include etudes, solos, or particular movements of solo works.
- Choose selections you feel confident playing and show off your skills please email Prof McCourt to approve alternate selections.

Graduate levels

- Concerto (complete) of the following: Vaughan Williams, John Williams, Bozza, Plau
- Snedecor Etude No. 3 or No. 5
- Orchestral Excerpts from the following list (please choose 2 contrabass and 2 bass tuba excerpts):

If you live more than **300 miles from campus, you may request a video audition.** Please note that full scholarship consideration may not be available to video auditions.
