2025 Bass auditions will consist of a live audition.

Auditions are scheduled at the time of application. To schedule your audition date, please <u>apply to the</u> <u>Conservatory</u>. Details about audition and application procedures can be found <u>on our website</u>. Deadline to apply is **December 15, 2024.**

LIVE AUDITION REPERTOIRE

Repertoire for the audition should be selected from traditional solo literature. The following examples represent acceptable audition repertoire for a performance major. Non-performance majors should perform repertoire which best demonstrates their level of ability.

Undergraduate

- One movement of a standard double bass concerto or comparable works from the standard repertoire.
- Two contrasting orchestral excerpts from the standard orchestral repertoire.

Master's level

- Two movements of a standard double bass concerto or comparable works from the standard repertoire.
- Three orchestral excerpts representing different styles and composers from the standard orchestral repertoire.
- One movement from any Bach unaccompanied suite for cello.

Doctoral level

- Two movements of a standard double bass concerto or comparable works from the standard repertoire.
- Four orchestral excerpts representing different styles and composers from the standard orchestral repertoire.
- Two contrasting movements from any Bach unaccompanied suite for cello.

Three audition dates are available:

- Saturday, February 8th, 2025
- Monday, February 17th, 2025
- Friday, March 7th, 2025

If you live more than **300 miles from campus, you may request a video audition.** Please note that full scholarship consideration may not be available to video auditions.

All applicants are very strongly advised to audition on campus. If scheduling difficulties or distances are insurmountable, applicants may request to audition via recording. Contact <u>cadmissions@umkc.edu</u> for approval.
