AUDITION REPERTOIRE INFORMATION 2025

2025 Viola auditions will consist of a **live audition**.

Auditions are scheduled at the time of application. To schedule your audition date, please [apply to the Conservatory](#). Details about audition and application procedures can be found [on our website](#). Deadline to apply is **December 15, 2024**.

Auditions are normally 10 minutes in length at the undergraduate level, 20 minutes at the master's level, and 30 minutes at the doctoral level. Non-performance majors are required to perform a 10-minute audition in their applied area.

AUDITION REPERTOIRE

Repertoire for the admission audition should be selected from traditional solo literature. The following examples represent acceptable audition repertoire for a performance major. Non-performance majors should perform repertoire which best demonstrates their level of ability. If you have questions about your repertoire choices, please contact Professor Lee (leesc@umkc.edu).

Undergraduate

1. Two contrasting movements of unaccompanied Bach
2. One movement from a concerto of the applicant's choosing
3. One movement from the standard (solo or duo) sonata repertoire.

Master's level

1. Two contrasting movements of unaccompanied Bach
2. A complete 20th century concerto
3. A complete sonata (solo or duo) from the standard repertoire.

Doctoral level

1. A major unaccompanied work.
2. A standard concerto (Bartók, Hindemith, Walton).
3. A standard sonata (Brahms, Schubert, Vieuxtemps).

The concerto and unaccompanied work should be performed from memory.

Three audition dates are available:

- Saturday, February 8th, 2025
- Monday, February 17th, 2025
- Friday, March 7th, 2025

If you live more than **300 miles from campus**, you may request a **video audition**. Please note that full scholarship consideration may not be available to video auditions.

All applicants are very strongly advised to audition on campus. If scheduling difficulties or distances are insurmountable, applicants may request to audition via recording. Contact cadmissions@umkc.edu for approval.
