LIVE AUDITION REPERTOIRE

Accompaniment may be used but is not required or expected.

Undergraduate Level

Recommended length of audition: approximately 10-15 minutes. Repertoire should include:

- Two contrasting solo works or movements
- Major and minor scales

Master of Music or Performer's Certificate

Recommended length of audition: approximately 20 minutes. Repertoire should include:

- Two contrasting solo works or movements of your choice
- Mozart Concerto in G or D: Movement 1 exposition
- Three orchestral excerpts

Doctor of Musical Arts or Artist's Certificate

Repertoire should include:

- Two contrasting complete solo works of your choice
- One baroque piece
- Mozart Concerto in G or D: Movement 1 exposition and Movement 2 exposition
- Three orchestral excerpts

Three audition dates are available:

- Saturday, February 4, 2023
- Monday, February 20, 2023
- Friday, March 3, 2023

If you live more than **300 miles from campus**, you may request a video audition. Please note that full scholarship consideration may not be available to video auditions.

All applicants are very strongly advised to audition on campus. If scheduling difficulties or distances are insurmountable, applicants may request to audition via recording. Contact cadmissions@umkc.edu for approval.
