

COLLABORATIVE PIANO APPLICATION/AUDITION INFORMATION 2024

2024 Piano auditions will consist of a live audition.

APPLICATION

- Auditions are scheduled at the time of application. To schedule your audition date, please <u>apply to the Conservatory</u>. Details about audition and application procedures can be found <u>on our website</u>. Deadline to apply is **December 15, 2023.**
- All applicants must submit a **list of collaborative and solo repertoire previously studied**, which should be uploaded to the application before submission. Please indicate works that have been performed in recital with an asterisk (*).
- By March 3, in addition to the live audition, all applicants must upload a 15-minute **video** recording of a LIVE performance with a partner of a collaborative duo music. It does not need to be the same repertoire as for the live audition. This is not a pre-screening video, but supplemental required material to support your application.
- Graduate students applying for assistantships must complete the GTA/TA section of the application.

AUDITION REPERTOIRE

Auditions are normally 20 minutes in length at the Master's level and are judged by the appropriate applied faculty.

For the live audition:

Prepare a 20-minute program, including:

- One art song
- One aria
- One instrumental sonata (at least one movement) of your choice
- One additional instrumental work of your choice, in a contrasting style

Sight reading will be requested by the auditioning committee.

All applicants must submit a program at least twenty (20) minutes in length for the live audition. This program should be uploaded to Slate at the time of application. For your audition, pieces from this list will be selected by the auditioning committee.

Three audition dates are available:

- Saturday, February 3, 2024
- Monday, February 19, 2024
- Friday, March 1, 2024

If you live more than **300 miles from campus, you may request a video audition.** Please note that full scholarship consideration may not be available to video auditions.

All applicants are very strongly advised to audition on campus. If scheduling difficulties or distances are insurmountable, applicants may request to audition via recording. Contact cadmissions@umkc.edu for approval.
